On November 25, 2015, an obituary appeared in *the New York Times* headlined:

**Douglass C. North, Maverick Economist,
Author and Nobel Laureate, Dies at 95**

Douglass C. North was the co-recipient, with Robert C. Fogel, of the Nobel Memorial Prize in Economics in 1993. In 1987 he and Andrew C. Rutten, who is on the faculty of the Political Science Department of Stanford University, contributed “The Northwest Ordinance in Historical Perspective” to *Essays on the Economy of the Old Northwest*, published by Ohio University Press and edited by David C. Klingaman and Richard K. Vedder, professors in the Economics Department of that University. Years later, I bought a copy of this book through a sale catalogue, skimmed its contents, and placed it on a shelf of my library. Jump ahead about fifteen years. In 2011, I took another look at it, and quickly saw that the North-Rutten article was a perfect fit for the Minnesota Legal History Project, which I had “launched” in 2008. I contacted Ohio University Press, which held the copyright, and was informed that, for republication purposes, I should contact the authors of the article. I emailed Professor North at Washington University, and somehow my request to post his article on a small, obscure, narrowly focused website (run by a retired lawyer, no less) reached him. He granted it provided I have

the article proofed by his co-author, Andrew Rutten. That done, I posted it in June 2011, and it has been one of the most frequently viewed articles on the MLHP website ever since (for the 30 days ending February 27, 2017, it was viewed 188 times).

“The Northwest Ordinance in Historical Perspective” complements “The Great Land Ordinances” by the late Jonathan Hughes, which also appeared in *Essays on the Economy of the Old Northwest*. It too has been viewed by several thousand viewers since it was first posted in June 2011 (in the 30 days from January 29 through February 27, 2017, it had 189 viewers).

With that we turn to the tables for 2015. Here are the results for November of that year.

November 1-30, 2015

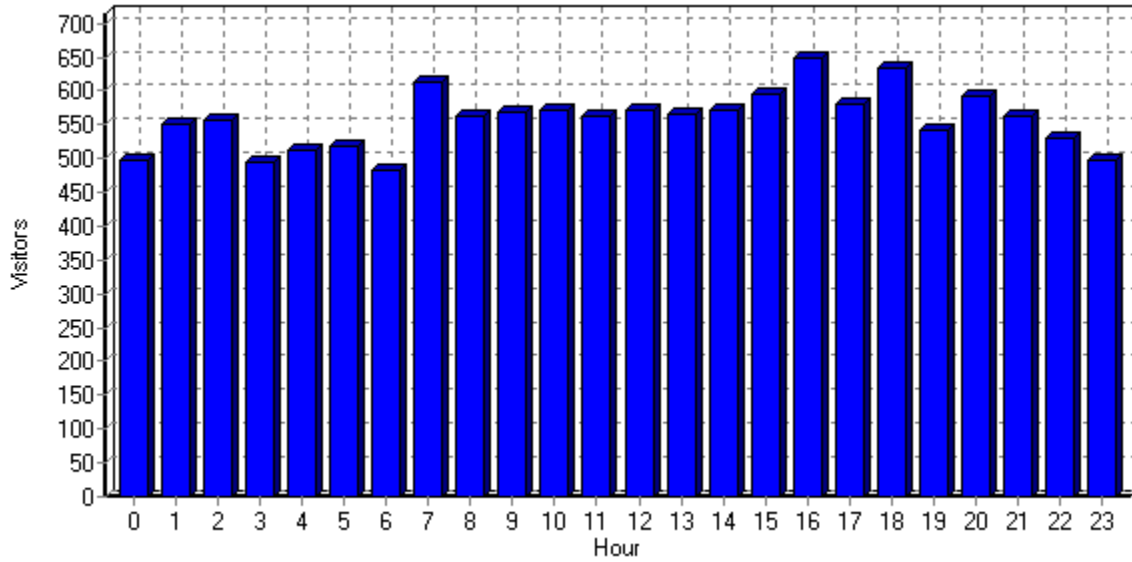

November 1-30, 2015

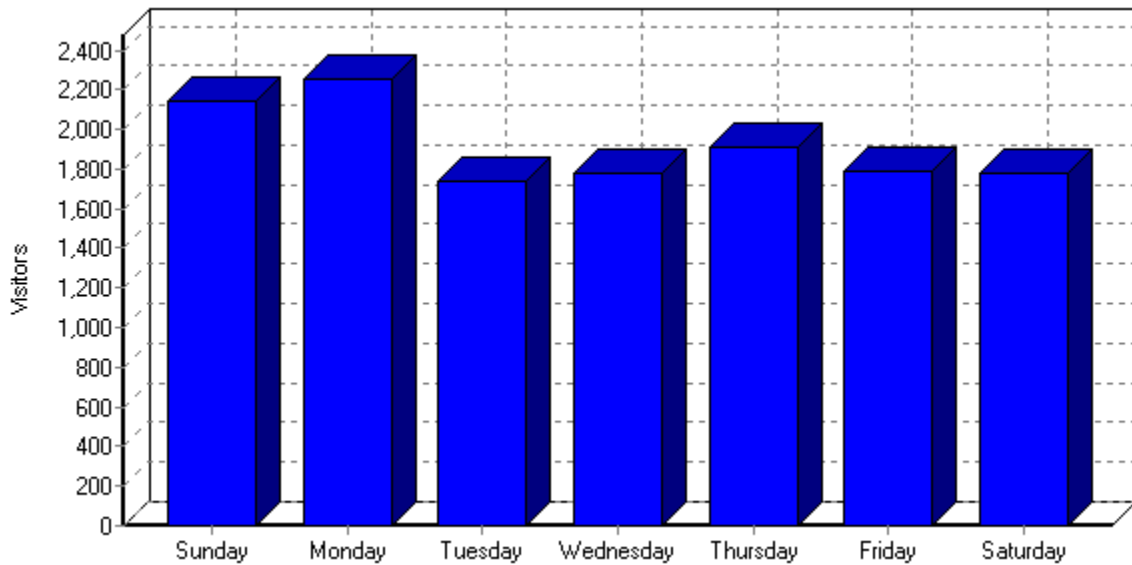
