
The Justice Harry A. Blackmun Oral History Project (1994-1995)

Harry Andrew Blackmun served on the United States Supreme Court from June 8, 1970, to August 3, 1994. At times, from July 6, 1994 to December 13, 1995, Harold A. Koh, a professor at Yale Law School and a former law clerk for the justice, interviewed him about his youth, legal education, practicing law in Minnesota, counsel for the Mayo Clinic, judge on the Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals (1959-1970) and service on the Supreme Court.
