HALE G.CARR was born at Onamia, Minnesota on October 1, 1900, the son of George H. Carr and Sarah Carr. He attended the Onamia elementary and high schools. He took his college work at Augsburg College, Minneapolis.

He received his law degree in 1941 from the Minneapolis College of Law and was admitted to practice before the Courts of the State of Minnesota in that year.

Mr Carr was regularly employed with the United States Postal Service and was a supervisor in that service at St. Paul, Minnesota where he was active in postal organizations and activities.

Mr. Carr was married in 1927 to Ethel Jensen. He left surviving him his widow and three sons, Hale G. Carr, Jr., of St. Paul; David Carr of St. Paul and Lowell Carr of Kansas City, Missouri. The family resided at 3110 Highway 61 in rural Ramsey County. His death occurred June 6, 1956.
