# Preface

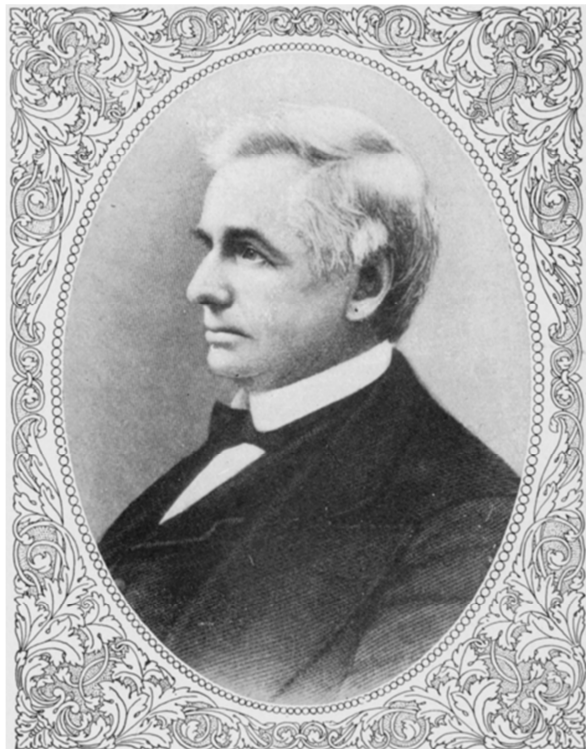

Aaron Goodrich, the first Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Minnesota Territory, died in St. Paul on June 24, 1887, at age seventy-nine. During his lifetime he had accumulated a large, eclectic library.

He purchased many books while serving as secretary of the U. S. Legation in Brussels, Belgium, during the Civil War not only because he seems to have had a slight case of bibliomania but also because he needed them to research and write his mammoth expose of Christopher Columbus, published in 1874. He considered the explorer an imposter, a fraud. To a degree, therefore, this was a working library.

His family decided to sell it. Realizing that it held many valuable and important volumes, they prepared and published an 86 page catalogue of the books. It was divided into three categories: Books on history, biography, religion, politics, etcetera, many in foreign languages; second, pamphlets (many pertaining to Minnesota); and, third, law books. "Catalogue of the Private Library of the Late Hon. Aaron Goodrich" is posted here.
