HUNT ON ACCORD AND SATISFACTION.

This work in one volume is by Mr. Alva R. Hunt, of the Minnesota Bar, who is also author of a *Treatise on the Law of Tender*, etc., which subject he also has treated in *Cyc.* Besides the subjects referred to in the title there is treated *Composition at Common Law*, and there follow the text forms for use in composition proceedings. The author states that in preparation of the work he has examined some 5,000 cases, and he has sought to make his treatment of the subjects embraced comprehensive.

The volume is logical in arrangement and its citation in notes to cases is very abundant indeed, and there is every evidence of the painstaking care to which the author refers in his preface. The subject is undoubtedly one of practical interest to the general practitioner, and its ready handling is secured by the excellent table of contents and useful index.
