MEMORIAL FOR LOUIS SOLEM
DATED MAY 1st, 1954.

Louis Solem was born on the 8th day of January, 1879, as the son of Lars L. and Anne P. Solem, at the City of Faribault, in the County Rice and State of Minnesota, and he, together with his parents, moved to Minneapolis, Minnesota, in the year of 1884. He was one of six brothers and Louis was the next to the oldest of the children; two of his brothers died at any early age, in infancy, only two weeks apart. Louis was married to Caroline Ballentine on the 24th day of May, 1905, and his wife survives him.

Louis died at the City of Minneapolis, Minnesota, on July 1st, 1953, and he was survived by his said wife and also by three brothers, namely, Oscar M. Solem, who is a Foot-Ball Coach at Springfield College in the State of Massachusetts, and by Dr. Paul O. Solem, a doctor of Dental Surgery, in the City of Minneapolis and also by Ludwig O. Solem, a Lawyer of the City of Minneapolis.

Louis was admitted to the Bar in June, 1902 and ever since said time, until his death, practiced Law in the City of Minneapolis, and he was assistant County Attorney under Al. J. Smith who was the County Attorney at the time.

Louis fought zealously for his clients and he was admired by his clients for his Loyalty, sound advice and honest efforts in their behalf.
