Edward Thompson Teitsworth was born in Elysburg, Pennsylvania on the 13th day of July, 1864. He died in Minneapolis on the 6th day of June, 1942.

He received his education in the common schools, Dickinson Seminary, and graduated from Depauw University in Indiana, in 1889.

Later he studied law and was a member of the Minnesota Bar for nearly 52 years. He was County Attorney for the County of Clearwater for two terms.

In 1893 he married Miss Mary Pearson who died in 1931. Later in 1934 he married Lulu May Shepard who survives him. He had one child, a son, Charles Teitsworth, who now lives in Springfield, Illinois, and is in the employ of the Pillsbury Flour Mills Co.

He had long been a member of the Hennepin Avenue Methodist Church, in which he took an active personal interest. He was a member of Ark Lodge, A.F. & A.M. of Minneapolis.

Mr. Teitsworth was an educated and well trained lawyer. He made a specialty in the study and examination of real estate titles.

In his practice he was esteemed by his associates at the bar as an attorney of much experience and was noted for his integrity.

He had the reputation of being a good lawyer; a good citizen and a Christian gentlemen.
