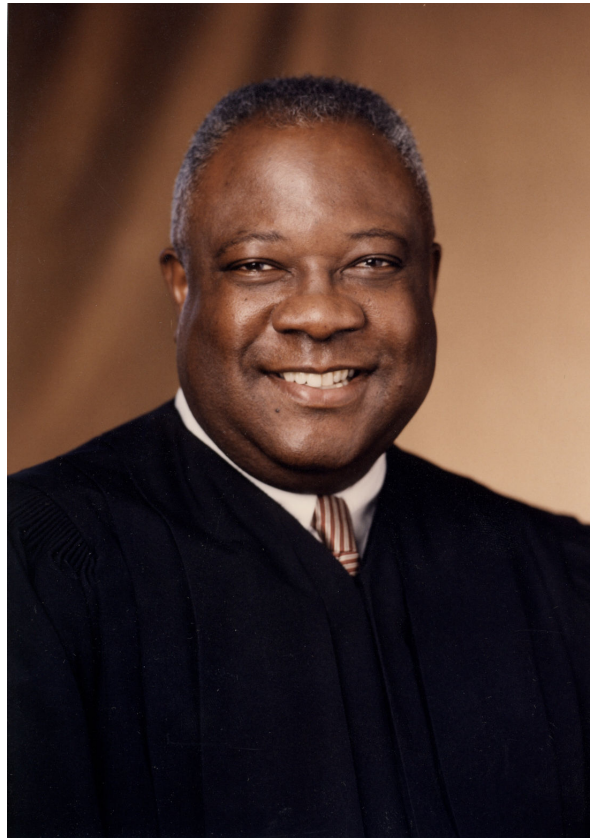

**Judge Edward Toussaint, Jr.**

A graduate of Chicago State University in 1964, and the DePaul University Law School in 1974, Edward Toussaint, Jr., served as a Workers Compensation Judge, 1981-1987, Judge of the Workers Compensation Court of Appeals, 1987-1992, and a Hennepin County District Court Judge, 1992-1995. He was appointed to the Appeals Court on March 13, 1995, and served as Chief Judge until November 1, 2010. He retired from the Court on July 15, 2011.
